The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deane. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Miller and Culbertson reported they completed an online security standards review required by the Virginia Department of Elections on February 17, 2021. It is due March 1, 2021.

Culbertson is in the process of reviewing and suggesting updates to the Greene County Electoral Board Voting Security Program, due to the Virginia Department of Elections by May 1, 2021.


The 2020 national census data will be released by September 30, 2021. Virginia redistricting plans are on hold until the data is available.


Democrats will hold a primary in early June; Republicans have not decided which way to conduct their primary electors.

The remainder of the meeting was given over to preparing for the statewide annual risk-limiting audit (RLA) of the November 2020 election. The Board viewed the Department of Elections seeding of ballots for the audit held via Zoom in Richmond.

The Board will meet again on February 24 at 9:30 a.m. to conduct Greene County's portion of the RLA and send the results to the Virginia Department of Elections. The Board selected Deane and Culbertson to conduct the ballot review.
