

The Greene County Electoral Board met March 16, 2021 at 9:30 a.m. at the Registrar's Annex in Stanardsville, VA.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deane.

The Registrar reported that a Greene County resident plans on running for the 58th District of the Virginia House of Delegates. Preliminary paperwork has been submitted by the candidate and petitions will be submitted directly to the Democratic Party.

Early voting for the Democratic Primary begins April 23 at the Registrar's Annex.

The Democratic Primary will take place on June 8, 2021. The Electoral Board will contact polling places and perform L&A testing on the voting machines.

The number of election officers needed at each precinct, based on likely numbers of voters, was set, as were other housekeeping measures regarding organization, management of ballot cages and keys, all according to previous years' procedures.

The Electoral Board will conduct three training sessions for Officers of Election in the Board of Supervisors room. Proper PPE for officials and voters will be discussed. Tentative schedule: May 24 at 6 pm, May 27 at 6 pm and June 1 at 10 am.

The Sheriff will be notified of the Primary Election and standard security measures will be requested.

The next Electoral Board meeting will be devoted to readying for the Democratic Primary.

Review of FOIA requirements was recommended by the Registrar. Culbertson offered to review the salient points as they pertain to the Registrar's office and the Electoral Board.


There being no further public business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:10 a.m.
