

MINUTES: Greene County Electoral Board
March 1, 2022

The Greene County Electoral Board meeting on **March 1, 2022** was called to order by the Chair, Deborah Turck, at 3:00 p.m. at the General Registrar's office in Stanardsville Virginia.

The agenda was adopted.

Minutes for preceding meetings were approved with amendments.

BOARD REPORTS

FOIA TRAINING

All Board members reported they had completed their FOIA online training.

PRECINCT SITES

Registrar and Electoral Board members recorded that new district boundary lines reflecting population growth were approved at the Board of Supervisors meeting on February 8, 2022.

On March 8, 2022 board Chair Deborah Turck will present a request that the Board of Supervisors approve the Holiday Inn Express in Ruckersville as the new polling location for Ruckersville Precinct. The increasing growth of Ruckersville in the southern area of Ruckersville Precinct makes this polling location more convenient for many voters. Calvary Chapel (located inside the Ruckersville Fire Station building) will become Ruckersville Precinct's emergency voting location.

Moved, seconded and approved to accept the Chair's report on sites, and presentation at the March 8, 2022 meeting.

POLLING LOCATIONS

The Chair reported the following as emergency polling place locations for future elections pending final signatures on contracts:

Town of Stanardsville: Stanardsville Town Hall

Ruckersville District: Calvary Chapel located in Ruckersville Firehouse

Stanardsville District: American Legion

Monroe, Dyke Precinct: Mt. Olivet Church

Monroe, Swift Run Precinct: Emmanuel Christian Center

Midway District: Emmanuel Christian Center

Moved, seconded, and approved by the Board to accept the report.

Discussion: Pending final approval by the State Board of Elections of new voting district boundary lines, board discussed best ways for voters to be notified of changes in their voting place prior to the June 21 election, in addition to required mailings.

REPORT ON VEBA BOOT CAMP, FEBRUARY 5, 2022

GR requested report on VEBA training attended by all Board members. Report covered discussions on security at polling locations, new legal requirements for election procedures, and other administrative issues.

GENERAL REGISTRAR'S REPORT

ASSIGNMENT OF OFFICERS OF ELECTION

The Board discussed General Registrar's proposed distribution of recently sworn Officers of Election (see February 1, 2022 minutes) among different precincts for the June 21, 2022 election. Approval of the list was moved by Chairman Turck, seconded by Secretary Culbertson, and duly agreed upon by voice vote.

SECURITY

Registrar noted that several reports are due regarding security of voting equipment and IT safety. The Board moved, voted, and approved the GR request that members work with the General Registrar as required to complete these reports on time and ensure they are up to date.

Registrar reported that replacement system for VERIS (the Virginia Election and Registration System) will not be completed this year. It was scheduled to roll out over the summer, however implementation of the new system has been delayed.

TRAINING


General Registrar reported that the Board and General Registrar will be trained in March on the use of new pollbooks for use in the June 21, 2022 election.

Discussion of training of Officers of Election on new pollbooks, likely to take longer than standard training. In addition to training meetings, the new pollbooks will be available for Officers of Election to practice on at the Registrar's office prior to the election.

Discussion of training in general and updating training materials and authorizations to comply with current ELECT requirements for training.


There being no other business, and after being duly moved and seconded, the Chair adjourned the meeting at 5:05 pm.


