

MINUTES: Greene County Electoral Board
Meeting June 22, 2022

The Greene County Electoral Board Canvass meeting for the June 21, 2022 Republican Primary met on Wednesday, **June 22, 2022**, at the General Registrar's office in Stanardsville, VA. The meeting was called to order by Chair Deborah Turck at 3:00 p.m.

Open Session

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chair Turck, who announced that this was the official canvass meeting for the June 21, 2022 Republican Primary, according to Sections 24.2.-671 to -24.2-680 of the Code of Virginia and would be conducted according to the processes in Section 14.2 of the Code of Virginia.

Closed Session

At 3:05 p.m. O'Regan moved to go into closed session to discuss provisional ballots, as authorized in Code of Virginia Section A 2.2-3711 and A 2.2-3712, under applicable exemption #2 in A 2.2-3711—protection of "privacy of individuals." Culbertson seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and agreed to. Closed session commenced.

At 3:35 p.m. O'Regan motioned to reconvene in open session, and Turck seconded the motion. The Board voted and returned to open session.

Open Session

The Greene County Electoral Board, certified that only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act as were identified in the motion covering the closed meeting were heard, discussed, or considered by the Board in the closed meeting.

The Board then voted to approve all provisional ballots.

The Board continued to review of voting reports from all precincts to verify their completeness and compliance with all reporting requirements under Virginia law.

The Chair opened all sealed envelopes containing precinct Statement of Results and the Board checked for complete and correct Statements of Results. The envelopes were resealed for delivery to the Circuit Court judge.

Having completed the review and ascertaining that all reports were in order, the official count of ballots for election day precincts were entered in the report regarding election results. The final Abstract of Votes are included on following page.

The Board suspended the meeting at 5:15 p.m. to reconvene at 10:00 a.m. on June 25, 2022 to continue and complete canvass.

The Canvass meeting of the Greene County Electoral Board for the June 21, 2022 Republican Primary continued at 10:05 a.m on Saturday, June 25, 2022.

Review of CAP and certification of election: The Electoral board completed the review of all voting tallies from Early Voting, Absentee Voting, post-election absentee ballots postmarked by June 21 and received up to June 24 at noon, and those delivered to the General Registrar's office or voting precincts on Election Day.

Board member O'Regan moved to certify the election and Culbertson seconded. The Board voted on the motion. The Greene County Electoral Board certified the election at 11:30 a.m. The Secretary and Board members signed and completed the Abstract of Votes and applied the seal of the County of Greene to the document.

Post-Election Administrative Discussion: The Board then reviewed the election process, including the use of the new pollbooks in the election process. Election officials have been asked to provide comments. The Board will hold a post-election meeting with precinct chiefs as a portion of its next official meeting on July 5, 2022.

It was agreed that Roberta Culbertson will attend the July 5, 2022 meeting electronically.




