The Greene County Electoral Board meeting of **March 9, 2023** was held at the office of the Director of Elections at 32 Stanard Street in Stanardsville, Virginia.

REGISTRAR'S REPORT

Currently, 14,869 registered voters in Greene County.

Inactive voters list continues to be culled. Reduced from 481 to 365 inactive voters as of 3/14/2023.

Election Day schedule for Board members reviewed including early morning assistance with precinct set-ups, precinct visits, and closing activities.

Equipment delivery details also reviewed.
Chief of Elections operations material to be distributed on March 30.

Election Chief training: March 30th at 7pm

VEBA Conference registrations were distributed.

Discussed Greene County IT department request of LESS compliance items requiring action for purposes of scheduling a timeline for completion.
O'Regan will compile summary of "Base" items warranting action and share with full board and Registrar prior to communicating with IT Director.
New chips were installed on merlin machines per notification from DemTech.

Next Meeting Date: March 23rd at 9:15 am for Closed Session prior to Officer of Elections Training session.


