

**MINUTES: Greene County Electoral Board
March 9, 2023**

The Greene County Electoral Board meeting of **March 9, 2023** was held at the office of the Director of Elections at 32 Stanard Street in Stanardsville, Virginia.

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Deborah Turck, at 9:03 a.m.

Chairperson Turck adjourned for the purpose of entering Closed Session at 9:04 am for discussion of separate topics pending litigation and election security in accordance with **Code of Virginia 2.2-3711 Section A(8) 8 and 24.2-681**

Returning to the open meeting at 11:10 am, the Chair asked for certification by individual voice vote that only matters named as the purpose of the meeting were discussed during the closed meeting. All Board members certified the content of the meeting. No actions were taken in the meeting.

Chairperson Turck moved and T. Boyd seconded to submit LESS compliance report to state of Virginia ELECT in accordance with Virginia Code 24.2 -410.2 (B). Motion approved 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS

- A. **Minutes** of February 2, 2023 were approved as revised following a reading a motion made by Turck, seconded by Boyd, and approved 3-0.

NEW BUSINESS

April 4th Special Election –

- A) Jennifer Lewis-Fowler reported 210 Early Vote ballots to date and 147 absentee ballots to date for the April 4th special election.

- B) Full staffing of election officers for April 4 date is near finalization. Boyd will join Midway Precinct and Turck will join Stanardsville Town to assist in early morning set-up of polling locations.
- C) VEBA Annual Meeting - Reservations confirmed for all three Board members' attendance.
- D) House Bill 1877 to modify early voting days has failed at state Senate level.
- E) Board and Director of Elections reviewed training dates and pre-processing activity sessions prior to April 4th election.

June Primary Election -

Registrar's Office is awaiting confirmation of contested races. No contested races have yet been identified. If no contested races, Primary would be unnecessary.


